

# Reading Race Track

**Sight word research:** Students should practice with just a few words at a time using this suggested routine:

- 1) Teacher shows the word. Student should say the word within 3 seconds without prompting.
- 2) If the student does not, teacher says: "This word is \_\_\_\_\_. You say it. Spell it. Say it again."
- 3) Teacher places this word just a couple of spaces back in the stack of words so they will see it again quickly.
- 4) It is also helpful to use the word in a sentence or phrase so they understand the context: Example: a box of juice.
- 5) Repeat until child can say words in the deck 3 times in a row without error.
- 6) Be careful about introducing visually similar words at the same time (ie: avoid *on/no*, *will/well*).

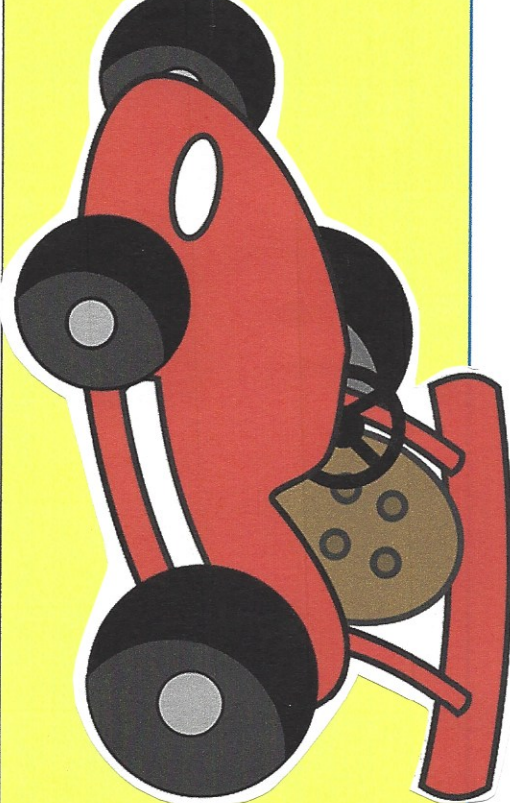
KG: 3-5 words per week    1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup>: 4-10 words per week

## **Reading Racetracks:**

- There are 2 versions: 1 for 5 sight words and 1 for 7 sight words. After practicing with a routine as above, conduct this timed session with individual students. Directions are on the racetrack. Recording sheets are attached.
- Variation for pairs or small groups to practice: Use 1 dice or number cube (1-6). Each student needs a game piece. Teacher writes the 5 or 7 sight words being practiced 4x each randomly around the chosen board. Player 1 rolls the die and moves that number of spaces. In order to stay on the space, the child must read the word correctly. Optional: The child must also use the word in a sentence. Continue with other players.

## Track



**Directions:** Teacher writes 5 different sight words 4x each randomly around the track. With a timer set for 1 minute, the teacher keeps track of words the student reads correctly and incorrectly. Keep going around the track until 1 minute is up. Set a goal for # of words to read correctly. Teacher helps student with missed words before repeating. Change words on the track when the goal is met.
